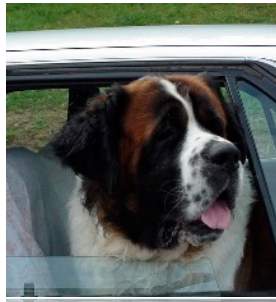

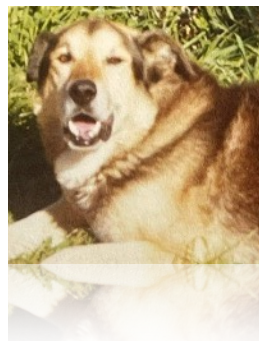
Albany Rotary Coatesville Garden Ramble, six amazing gardens, open Sunday November 9th. If you have not yet got tickets, they are available to buy online.
